A: If you want a complete ISO image, use `dd if=my_windows_install.iso of=/dev/sdX` If you want to extract the files from the ISO image, use `mkisofs -iso-level 3 -no-gpt-chs -o windows7.iso -b isolinux/isolinux.bin -c isolinux/boot.cat -no-emul-boot -boot-load-size 4 -boot-info-table windows7.iso /dev/sdX` where `/dev/sdX` is your first hard disk drive. Also, make sure to check the filesize before you download the ISO! When I downloaded the ISO image of Windows 7 Enterprise x64 via StartDownload there was a 1,7 GB sized file, when there was actually only 1,4 GB of files on the ISO file. A: You can use Unetbootin to burn it to a USB drive. North Korean leader Kim Jong-un has blamed his country's missile and nuclear weapons programme on the US, according to an article in a state newspaper, Pyongyang's latest effort to discredit the Trump administration. In the article, which appeared in Rodong Sinmun, Kim Jong-un accused the US of "play[ing] the role of a spoiler that does not know how to yield to reason and is always fanning the flames of confrontation to disturb the country's peace and security". "The entire US mainland is within range of our nuclear weapons, and a nuclear button is always on our desks," the article added. Kim also asserted that Pyongyang's military "strike capabilities are the maximum, and its nuclear button is a solemn pledge to the US". North Korea has previously threatened to use its nuclear weapons against the US. At the UN on Tuesday, Nikki Haley, the US ambassador to the UN, said the US would not hesitate to defend itself or its allies from North Korea's "reckless behaviour". Trump said on Monday he would not rule out a military option for dealing with North Korea. In his article, Kim said North Korea was working to strengthen nuclear deterrence to protect the country from "US hostility". Pyongyang
